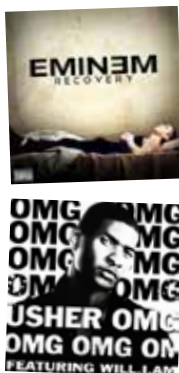
'NIGHT RACE'

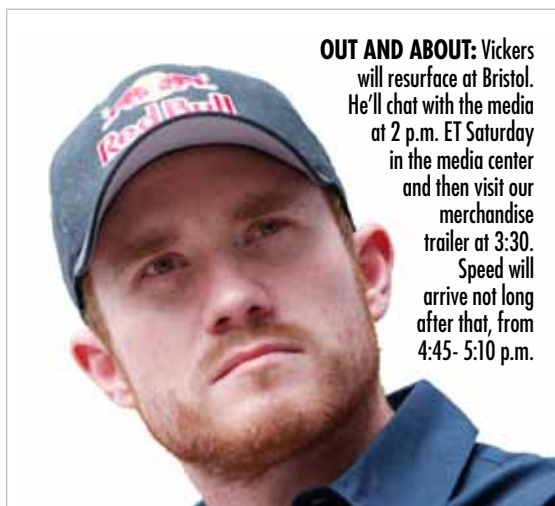

In July 1961, Fred Lorenzen won the pole with a lap of 79.225 mph. Earlier this season, Joey Logano won it with a 124.630-mph lap. That's nearly a mile per hour per year.
